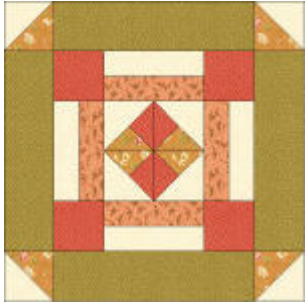

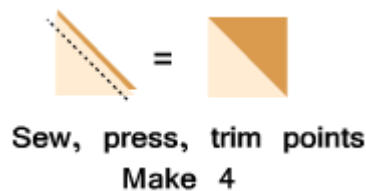
Cutting Instructions:

Fabric:	Size & Shape:	# to Cut:	*2nd Cut:
A (Red)	3-1/2" Square	4	
A (Red)	4-1/4" Square	1	
B (Pink)	2" x 6-1/2" Rectangle	4	
C (Tan)	3-7/8" Square	2	
C (Tan)	4-1/4" Square	1	
D (Green)	3-1/2" x 12-1/2" Rectangle	4	
E (Cream)	3-7/8" Square	4	
E (Cream)	2" x 6-1/2" Rectangle	4	

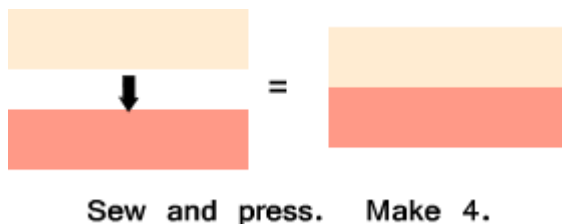
* = Cut once diagonally. = Cut twice diagonally.

Sewing Instructions:

Step 1: Layer a Color E (cream) 3-7/8" triangle on a Color C (tan) 3-7/8" triangle, right sides together. Stitch as shown below. Press the seam allowance toward the darker fabric and trim points. Make 4. (Each unit should measure 3-1/2".)



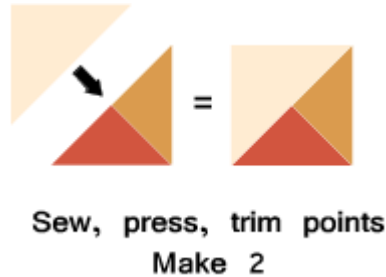
Step 2: Layer a Color E (cream) 2" x 6-1/2" rectangle on a Color B (pink) 2" x 6-1/2" rectangle, right sides together. Stitch along one long side. Press the seam allowance toward the darker fabric. Make 4. (Each unit should measure 3-1/2" x 6-1/2".)



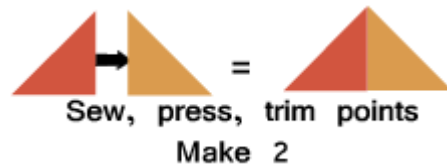
Step 3: Sew a 4-1/4" Color C (tan) triangle to a 4-1/4" Color A (red) triangle, as shown below. Press seam allowance toward the darker fabric and trim points. Make 2.



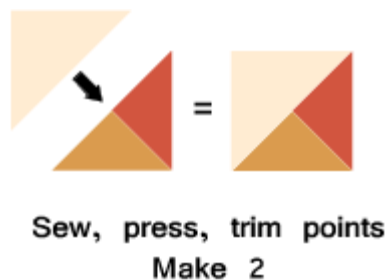
Next, sew a 3-7/8" Color E (cream) triangle to the Color C/A triangle, as shown below. Press seam allowance toward the larger triangle and trim points. Make 2. (This unit will measure 3-1/2" x 3-1/2".)



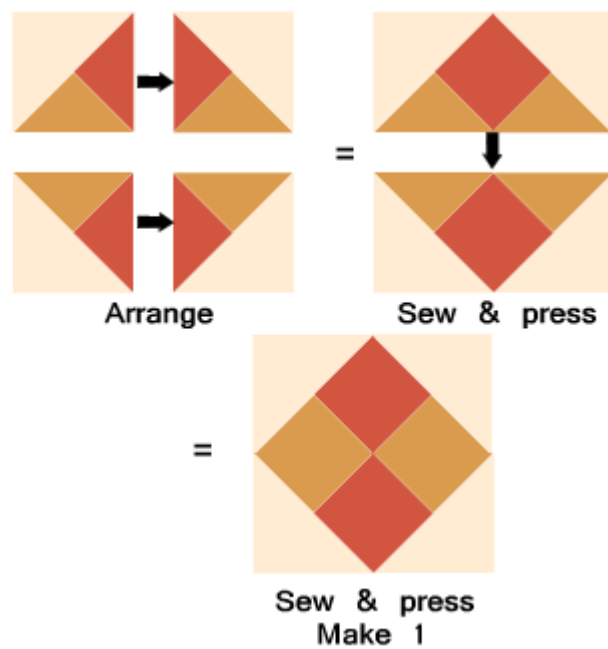
Step 4: Sew a 4-1/4" Color A (red) triangle to a 4-1/4" Color C (tan) triangle, as shown below. Press seam allowance toward the darker fabric and trim points. Make 2.



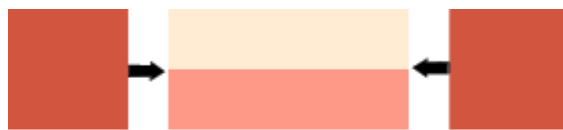
Next, sew a 3-7/8" Color E (cream) triangle to the Color A/C triangle, as shown below. Press seam allowance toward the larger triangle and trim points. Make 2. (This unit will measure 3-1/2" x 3-1/2".)



Step 5: Arrange the Step 3 and Step 4 units, as shown below. Sew into rows and press the seam allowances to one side. Sew the two rows together to finish the center unit. Press the seam allowance to one side. Make 1. (This unit should measure 6-1/2" x 6-1/2".)

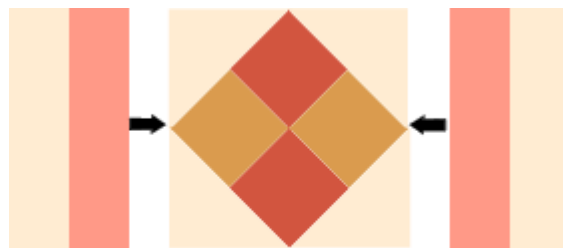


Step 6: Sew a 3-1/2" Color A (red) square to each end of a Step 2 unit, as shown below. Press the seam allowances toward the Color A square. Make 2. (This unit should measure 3-1/2" x 12-1/2".)



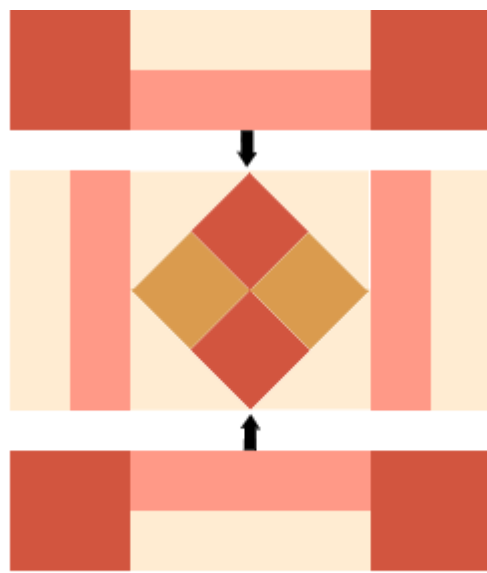
Sew and press. Make 2.

Step 7: Sew a Step 2 unit to each end of the Step 5 unit. Press seam allowances toward the Color B fabric. (This unit should measure 12-1/2" x 6-1/2".)



Sew and press.

Step 8: Sew a Step 6 unit to the top and bottom of the Step 7 unit. Press seam allowances toward the Step 6 unit. (This unit should measure 12-1/2" x 12-1/2".)

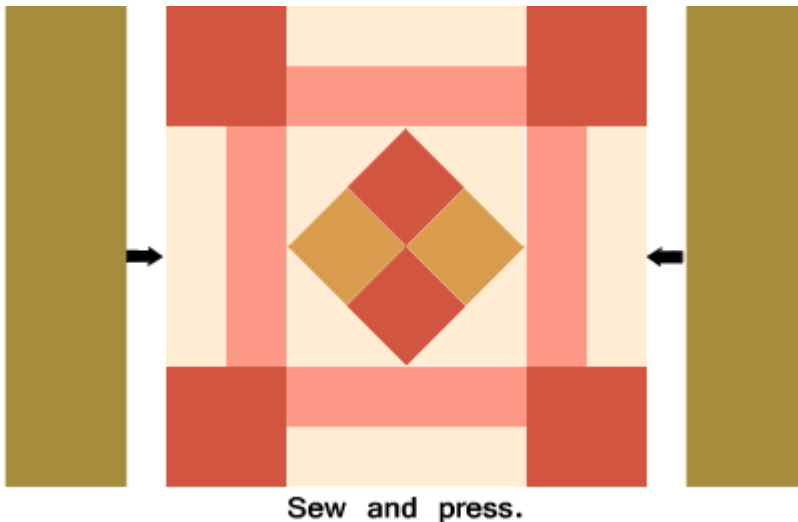


Sew and press.

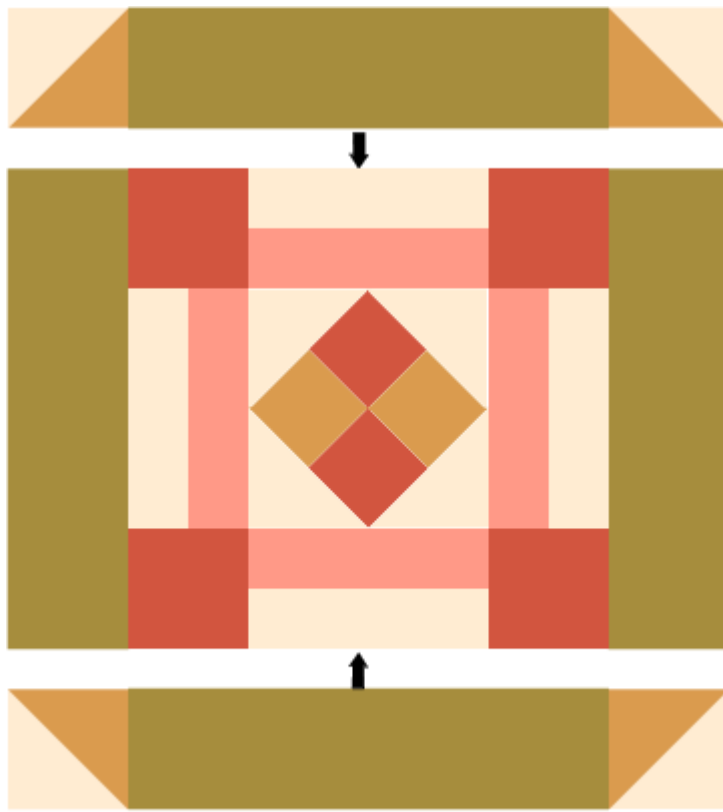
Step 9: Stitch a Step 1 unit to the left and right ends of a Color D (green) 3-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangle, as shown below. Press the seam allowances toward the Color D fabric. (Each unit should measure 3-1/2" x 18-1/2".)



Step 10: Stitch a Color D (green) 3-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangle to the left and right sides of the Step 8 unit. Press the seam allowances toward the Color D fabric.



Step 11: Stitch a Step 9 unit to the top and bottom of the block. Press the seam allowances away from the block center.



Sew and press.

Your block should measure 18-1/2" at this point. It will measure 18" when it is sewn into the quilt.

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
