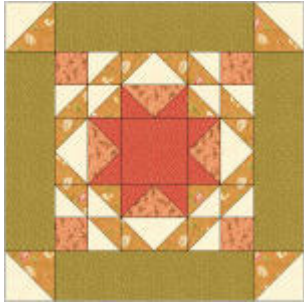

Cutting Instructions:

Fabric:	Size & Shape:	# to Cut:	*2nd Cut:
A (Red)	4-1/2" Square	1	
A (Red)	2-7/8" Square	4	
B (Pink)	2-1/2" Square	4	
B (Pink)	5-1/4" Square	1	
C (Tan)	2-7/8" Square	10	
C (Tan)	3-7/8" Square	2	
D(Green)	3-1/2" x 12-1/2" Rectangle	4	
E(Cream)	2-7/8" Square	6	
E (Cream)	3-7/8" Square	2	
E (Cream)	5-1/4" Square	1	

* = Cut once diagonally. = Cut twice diagonally.

Sewing Instructions:

Step 1: Layer a Color E (cream) 3-7/8" triangle on a Color C (tan) 3-7/8" triangle, right sides together. Stitch as shown below. Press the seam allowance toward the darker fabric and trim points. Make 4. (Each unit should measure 3-1/2".)



Sew, press, trim points

Step 2: Layer a Color E (cream) 2-7/8" triangle on a Color C (tan) 2-7/8" triangle, right sides together. Stitch as shown below. Press the seam allowance toward the lighter fabric and trim points. Make 12. (Each unit should measure 2-1/2".)



Sew, press, trim points
Make 12

Step 3: Sew a 2-7/8" Color C (tan) triangle to the right end of a 5-1/4" Color E (cream) triangle as shown below. Press seam allowance toward the darker fabric and trim points.

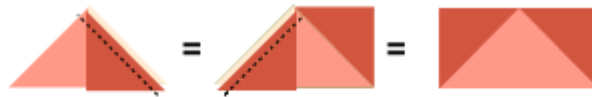
Repeat on the left end of the same triangle, as shown below. Press seam allowance toward the darker fabric and trim points. Make 4. (Each unit should measure 2-1/2" x 4-1/2".)

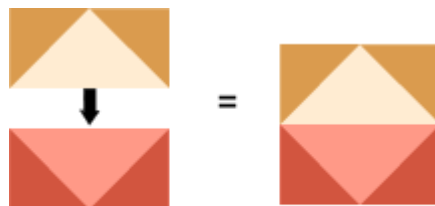
Step 4: Sew a 2-7/8" Color A (red) triangle to the right end of a 5-1/4" Color B (pink) triangle as shown below. Press seam allowance toward the darker fabric and trim points. Repeat on the left end of the same triangle, as shown below. Press seam allowance toward the darker fabric and trim points. Make 4. (Each unit should measure 2-1/2" x 4-1/2".)

Repeat on the left end of the same triangle, as shown below. Press seam allowance toward the darker fabric and trim points. Make 4. (Each unit should measure 2-1/2" x 4-1/2".)



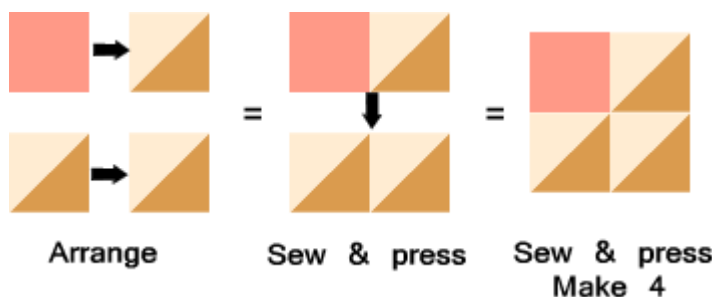
Sew, press, trim points

Step 5: Sew a Step 3 and Step 4 unit together, as shown below. Press the seam allowance toward the Step 4 unit. Make 4. (This unit should measure 4-1/2" x 4-1/2".)



Sew and press. Make 4

Step 6: Arrange a Color B (pink) 2-1/2" square and three Step 2 units as shown below. Sew into rows and press the seam allowance of the top row toward the Color B square. Press the seam allowance of the bottom row in the opposite direction. Sew the two rows together to finish the unit. Press the seam allowance toward the upper row. Make 4. (This unit should measure 4-1/2" x 4-1/2".)

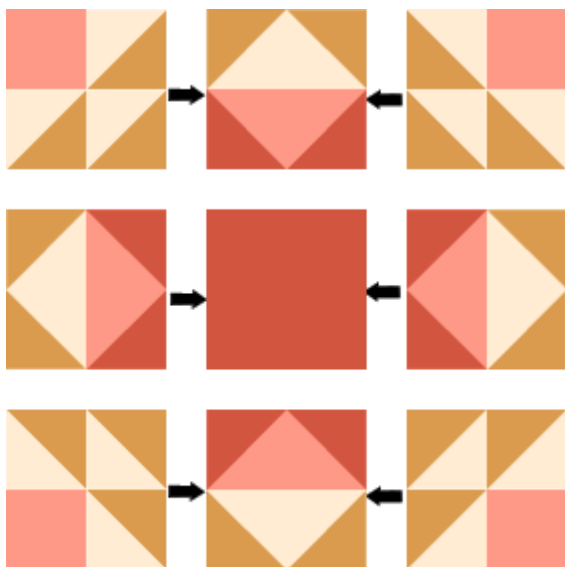

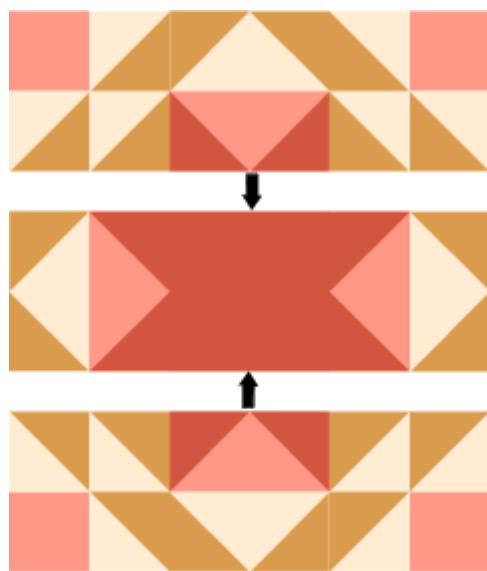

Step 7: Arrange the Step 5 and Step 6 units and the 4-1/2" Color A (red) square, as shown below. Sew into rows and press the seam allowances for the top and bottom row toward the Step 5 units. Press the seam allowances for the center row toward the Color A square.



Arrange, sew, and press.

Next, sew the rows together to finish the center block unit. Press the seam allowances toward the center row. Make 1. (This unit should measure 12-1/2" x 12-1/2")



Arrange, sew, and press.

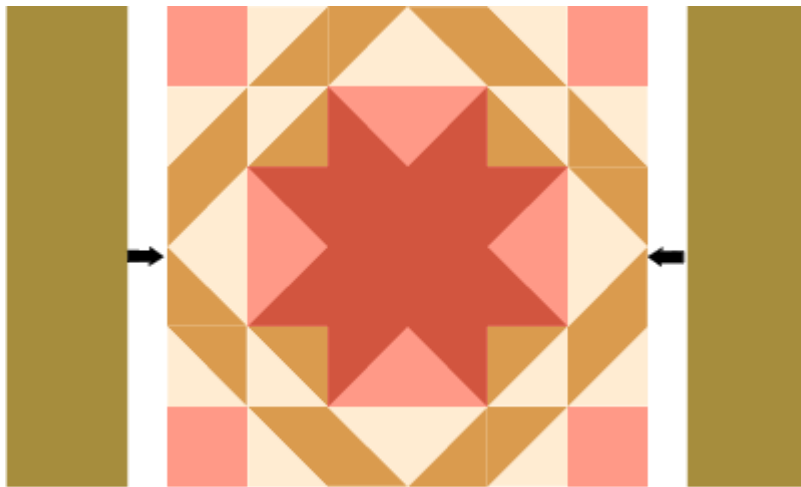
Step 8: Stitch a Step 1 unit to the left and right ends of a Color D (green) 3-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangle, as shown below. Press the seam allowances toward the Color D fabric. (Each unit should measure 3-1/2" x 18-1/2".)



Sew and press. Make 2.

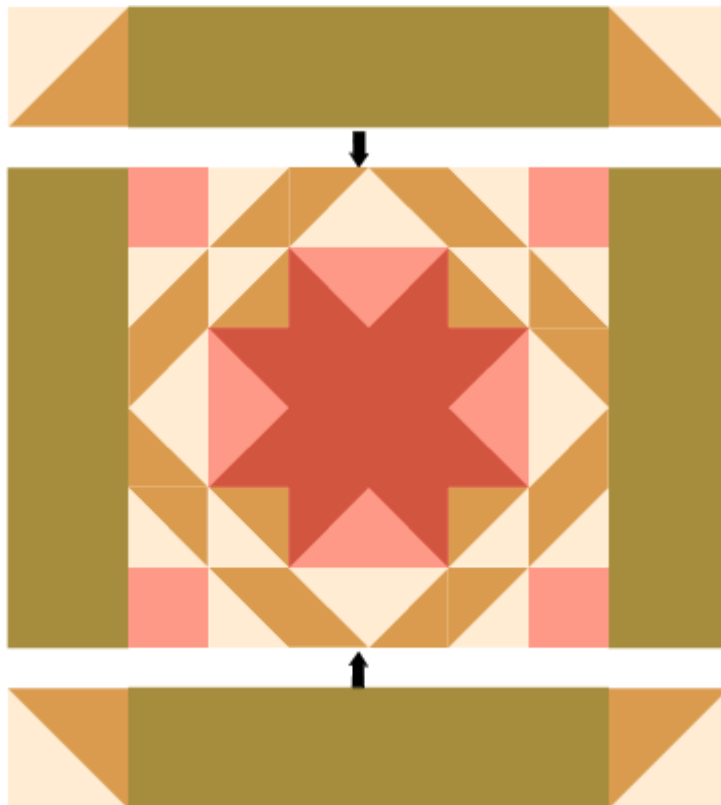
Step 9: Stitch a Color D (green) 3-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangle to the left and right sides of the

Step 8 unit. Press the seam allowances toward the Color D fabric.



Sew and press.

Step 10: Stitch a Step 8 unit to the top and bottom of the block. Press the seam allowances away from the block center.



Sew and press.

Your block should measure 18-1/2" at this point. It will measure 18" when it is sewn into the quilt.

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
